

## اللَّهُمَّ ادْخِلْ عَلَيَّ a) Allāhumma Adkhill A'laa

In 'al-Miṣbāḥ' and in 'al-Balad al-Amīn', Shaykh al-Kaf`amiy, as well as Shaykh al-Shahīd in 'al-Majmū`ah', have narrated that the Holy Prophet (a.s) said that one who says the following supplication after each obligatory prayer in Ramaḍān will have all his sins forgiven up to the Resurrection Day:

O Allah: (please do) bring in pleasure to the inhabitants of graves (i.e. the dead).

allāhumma adkhill `alā

اللَّهُمَّ ادْخِلْ عَلَيَّ أَهْلَ

الْقُبُورِ السُّرُورِ،

O Allah: (please do) enhance all poor ones.

allāhumma aghni kulla  
faqīr

اللَّهُمَّ اغْنِ كُلَّ فَقِيرٍ،

O Allah: (please do) satisfy all hungry ones.

allāhumma ashbi' kulla  
jā' i'

اللَّهُمَّ اشْبِعْ كُلَّ جَائِعٍ،

O Allah: (please do) provide all the naked with clothes.

allāhummaksu kulla  
`uryān

اللَّهُمَّ اكْسُ كُلَّ عُرْيَانٍ،

O Allah: (please do) help all the debtors settle their debts.

allāhummaqḍi dayna kulli  
madīn

اللَّهُمَّ اقْضِ دَيْنَ كُلِّ

مَدِينٍ،

O Allah: (please do) relieve all the aggrieved ones.

allāhumma farrij `an kulli  
makrūb

اللَّهُمَّ فَرِّجْ عَن كُلِّ

مَكْرُوبٍ،

O Allah: (please do) help all the strangers to return home.

allāhumma rudda kulla  
gharīb

اللَّهُمَّ رُدِّ كُلَّ غَرِيبٍ،

O Allah: (please do) release all prisoners.

allāhumma fukka kulla  
asīr

اللَّهُمَّ فَكِّ كُلَّ أَسِيرٍ،

O Allah: (please do) rectify all the Muslims' affairs that are wrong.

allāhumma aṣliḥ kulla  
fāsidin min umūril-  
muslimīn

اللَّهُمَّ أَصْلِحْ كُلَّ فَاسِدٍ مِّنْ

أُمُورِ الْمُسْلِمِينَ،

O Allah: (please do) heal all the ailed ones.

allāhum mashfi kulla  
marīḍ

اللَّهُمَّ اشْفِ كُلَّ مَرِيضٍ،

O Allah: (please do) fill in our poverty with Your richness.

allāhumma sudda faqranā  
bighināk

اللَّهُمَّ سُدِّ فَقْرَنَا بِغِنَاكَ،

O Allah: (please do) change our ill manners through Your excellent manners.

allāhumma ghayyir sū`a ḥālinā biḥusni ḥālik

اللَّهُمَّ غَيِّرْ سُوءَ حَالِنَا

بِحُسْنِ حَالِكَ،

O Allah: (please do) help us settle our debts and save us from poverty.

allāhumma qḍi `annad-dayna wa aghninā minal-faqr

اللَّهُمَّ اقْضِ عَنَّا الدَّيْنَ

وَأَغْنِنَا مِنَ الْفَقْرِ،

verily, You have power over all things.

innaka `alā kulli shay`in qadīr

إِنَّكَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ.

### b) Allahummar zuqni Hajja اللَّهُمَّ ارْزُقْنِي حَجَّ

O Allah: (please) confer upon me with the grace of pilgrimage to Your Holy House,

allāhummar-zuqnī ḥajja baytikal-ḥarām

اللَّهُمَّ ارْزُقْنِي حَجَّ بَيْتِكَ

الْحَرَامِ

in this year and every year

fī `āmī hādhā wafī kulli `ām

فِي عَامِي هَذَا وَفِي كُلِّ

عَامٍ

as long as You keep me alive, with easiness, good health, and expansive sustenance from You.

mā abqaytanī fī yusrin minka wa`āfiyatin wasa`ati rizq

مَا أَبْقَيْتَنِي فِي يُسْرٍ مِنْكَ

وَعَافِيَةٍ وَسَعَةٍ رِزْقٍ،

and do not deprive me of these noble situations,

walā tukhlinī min tilkal-mawāqifil-karīmah

وَلَا تُخْلِنِي مِنْ تِلْكَ

الْمَوَاقِفِ الْكَرِيمَةِ،

and holy places,

wal-mashāhidish-sharīfah

وَالْمَشَاهِدِ الشَّرِيفَةِ،

and visiting the tomb of Your Prophet—may Your blessings be upon him and his Household;

waziyārati qabri nabīyyika ṣalawātuka `alayhi wa-ālih

وَزِيَارَةِ قَبْرِ نَبِيِّكَ صَلَوَاتِكَ

عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ،

and (please) stand for me in all of my needs for this worldly life and the Next World.

وَالْآخِرَةِ فَكُنْ لِي

O Allah: I beseech You regarding that which You decide and determine

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ فِي مَا  
تَقْضِي وَتُقَدِّرُ

from the inevitable decisions that You make on the Grand Night—

minal-amril-maḥtūmi fī laylatil-qadr

مِنَ الْأَمْرِ الْمَحْتُومِ فِي  
لَيْلَةِ الْقَدْرِ

decisions that are neither retreated nor altered—

minal-qadhā`il-ladhī lā yuraddu walā yubaddal

مِنَ الْقَضَاءِ الَّذِي لَا يُرَدُّ وَلَا  
يُبَدَّلُ

that You may include me with the pilgrims to Your Holy House,

an taktubanī min ḥujjāji baytikal-ḥarām

whose pilgrimage is admitted by You

al-mabrūri ḥajjuhum

and whose sins are forgiven by You,

and whose offenses are pardoned by You,

al-mukaffari `anhum sayyi`ātuhum

الْمُكَفَّرِ عَنْهُمْ سَيِّئَاتِهِمْ،

and that You, also within Your determined decisions,

waj-`al fī mā taqḍī watuqaddir

وَاجْعَلْ فِي مَا تَقْضِي  
وَتُقَدِّرُ

that You decide for me a long life,

an tuṭīla `umrī

أَنْ تُطِيلَ عُمْرِي

and expansive sustenance,

it is the month of Ramaḍān during which You revealed the Qur`ān

ladhī anzalta fihil-qur`āna

وَهُوَ شَهْرُ رَمَضَانَ الَّذِي

أَنْزَلْتَ فِيهِ الْقُرْآنَ

Ramadhan Month duas to be recited after Obligatory Salaat

as guidance for people and clear proofs on true guidance and distinction (between the right and the wrong);

hudan lin-nāsi wabayyinātin  
minal-hudā wal-furqāni

هُدًى لِلنَّاسِ وَبَيِّنَاتٍ مِّنَ  
الْهُدَى وَالْفُرْقَانِ

and You decided the Grand Night to be in it,

waja'alta fihi laylatal-qadri

وَجَعَلْتَ فِيهِ لَيْلَةَ الْقَدْرِ

and You have decided it to be more favorable that one thousand months.

## D)DU`Ā' AL-HAJJ

In *'al-Kāfi'*, al-Kulayniy has narrated on the authority of Abū-Baṣīr that Imam al-Ṣādiq (a.s) used to say the following supplication in Ramaḍān:

O Allah: From You and by You, I beseech for settling my need,	allāhumma innī bika waminka aṭlubu ḥājati	اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي بِكَ وَمِنْكَ أَطْلُبُ حَاجَتِي،
If others beg people for settling their needs,	waman ṭalaba ḥājatan ilan- nās	وَمَنْ طَلَبَ حَاجَةً إِلَى النَّاسِ
I ask none except You for settling my need;	fa-innī lā aṭlubu ḥājati illā mink	فَإِنِّي لَا أَطْلُبُ حَاجَتِي إِلَّا مِنْكَ
From You alone, since You have no partner with You	waḥdaka lā sharīka lak	وَحَدَّكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ،
and I thus implore You in the name of Your favor and Your pleasure,	wa-as`aluka bifaḍlika wariḍwānik	وَأَسْأَلُكَ بِفَضْلِكَ وَرِضْوَانِكَ
to send blessings upon Muhammad and his Household,	an tuṣalliya `alā muḥammadin wa-ahli baytih	أَنْ تُصَلِّيَ عَلَيَّ مُحَمَّدٍ وَأَهْلِ بَيْتِهِ

زَاكِيَةٌ خَالِصَةً لَكَ

By which You delight me,

And raise my rank with You

watarfa'u bihā darajati

وَتَرْفَعُ بِهَا دَرَجَتِي،

And to confer upon me with the grace of making me cast my sight down (against what is illegal for me to look at)

وَتَرزُقْنِي أَنْ أُغْضَّ

And making me act chastely

wa-an aḥfaẓa farjī

And making me stop committing any deed that You have deemed unlawful

wa-an akuffa bihā `an jamī'i maḥārimik

وَأَنْ أَكْفَّ بِهَا عَنْ جَمِيعِ

مَحَارِمِكَ

So that nothing will be more preferred in my sight than the obedience to You and the fear of You

ḥattā lā yakūna shay`un āthara `indī min ṭā'atika wakhshyatik

عِنْدِي مِنْ طَاعَتِكَ

وَخَشْيَتِكَ

And doing all that which You love,

And avoiding all that which You have detested and warned against.

And (please) make all that take place with easiness, lenience, and good health as well as the grave that You have bestowed upon me.

And I beseech You to cause me to die as martyr for Your sake,

وَأَسْأَلُكَ أَنْ تَجْعَلَ

Under the pennon of Your Prophet  
and in the line of Your intimate  
servants.

taḥta rāyati nabīyyik ma'a  
awliyā`ik

وَفَاتِي قَتْلًا فِي سَبِيلِكَ  
تَحْتَ رَايَةِ نَبِيِّكَ مَعَ  
أَوْلِيَاءِكَ،

And I ask You to make me the  
means of killing Your enemies and  
the enemies of Your Messenger.

And I ask You to honor me  
through humiliating any one of  
Your created beings that You  
choose,

wa-as`aluka an tukrimanī  
bihawāni man shi`ta min  
khalqik

وَأَسْأَلُكَ أَنْ تُكْرِمَنِي  
بِهَوَانٍ مِنْ شَيْءٍ مِنْ  
خَلْقِكَ

And not to humiliate me through  
honoring any of Your intimate  
servants.

walā tuhinnī bikarāmati  
aḥadin min awliyā`ik

وَلَا تُهِنِّي بِكَرَامَةِ أَحَدٍ  
مِنْ أَوْلِيَاءِكَ.

O Allah: find me a way with the  
Messenger.

allāhummaj'al lī ma'ar-  
rasūli sabīlā

اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْ لِي مَعَ  
الرَّسُولِ سَبِيلًا،

Allah is Sufficient unto me! Only  
that which Allah wants shall take  
place.

ḥasbiyallāhu mā shā' allāh.

حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ، مَا شَاءَ  
اللَّهُ.
